With reference Notification 15/2021-CT dated 18.05.2021, to blocking of

GSTIN for e-Way Bill generation is now considered only for the defaulting

Supplier GSTIN and not for the defaulting Recipient or Transporter GSTIN.

Mode of transport Ship is now updated as **Ship / Road cum Ship** so that the

user can enter Vehicle number in case the goods are moved by Road

initially, and for movement by Ship, the Bill of lading Number and date may

be entered. This will help in availing the ODC benefits for movement using

Ship and facilitate updating of vehicle details as and when moved on Road.

Suspended GSTIN as supplier cannot generate e-way bill. However, the

Suspended GSTIN as recipient or as transporter can get the e-way bill

generated.

1) For the report on e-way bills about to expire, a download Excel option is

provided.

2) In the Outward Supplies report an additional column for mode of

generation is provided.
